

David Tree Graduate Scholarship In Mechanical Engineering Announcement

The David Tree Graduate Scholarship is funded by the David Tree Graduate Support Fund in Mechanical Engineering to honor Mechanical Engineering professor Dr. David R. Tree's legacy. The scholarship will support ME graduate students in acoustics/ noise vibration area, which was Dr. Tree's main field of academic interest. Each recipient will receive a scholarship of \$4,000.

Eligibility:

Graduate students who study or doing research in acoustics/ noise vibration are eligible to apply.

Selection criteria:

1. Excellent academic achievement.
2. Excellent research performance.
3. Leadership within a research group or community, including mentoring of graduate and undergraduate students.

Application will consist of:

- A resume indicates study or research interests.
- Up to date transcripts.
- An essay from the student to describe how they meet above selection criteria.
- A recommendation letter from ME faculty.
